We have been working at Bedford Hospital for over 25 years & have just finished 2 more projects. EVC INSTALLATION

Wadys now a supply and install electric vehicle charging points for both domestic and commercial clients. Wadys are registered with the Office for Low Emission Vehicles (OLEV), which means that we are authorised to install EV charging points to domestic and commercial customers under the governments grant scheme. Under the Workplace Charging Scheme, the government contribution is limited to the 75% of purchase and installation costs, up to a maximum of £500 for each socket, up to a maximum of 20 across all sites for each applicant.
